Thank you to Troop 194 for assembling the 700 kits! That was quite the assembly line!




EAGLE SCOUT SPOTLIGHT



Eagle Project Description: Chase constructed a 9-hole disc golf course at Roosevelt Middle School. Holes were dug and posts set in concrete with removable baskets so they can be taken down in the winter months. Pavers were set at each tee box.

Eagle Project Description: Joseph cleared the savanna area of invasive multifloral rose bushes, making the area more accessible for hiking and nature preserve for Clayton County Conservation.





Eagle Project Description: Henry constructed raised garden beds out of galvanized tanks for the Eagle Point Place retirement home.

Eagle Project Description: Reed constructed 12 bluebird houses, a mallard cylinder, and a barn owl box for Dubuque County Conservation to place on the restored land at McCarthy Rd.





Eagle Project Description: Benjamin cleaned, scraped, rinsed, and repainted the vessel of the Bellevue Swimming pool.

Eagle Project Description: Mason prepared the ground, poured a 14 'x20' cement pad, and constructed and placed a 12' handicap accessible picnic table on the slab at Sunnycrest Manor in Dubuque. Mason also planted a tree next to the area.





Eagle Project Description: Ethan reconstructed the stairs on the trail by the Julien Dubuque Monument. Erosion and wash out was causing the current trail to deteriorate quickly. Stairs were redone, landscaping completed, and grass seed added to help stabilize the ground.
