2024 BSA NATIONAL MEMBERSHIP FEE UPDATES



2024 BSA National Annual Membership Fees

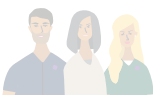
\$87/YR Participants in kindergarten through age 20.



\$52/YR For all Exploring youth and adults.



\$67/YR All registered adult volunteers in unit and non-unit positions. (Volunteers with multiple registrations will continue to pay for only one position).



\$27/YR This fee is for Merit Badge Counselors **who are not already registered volunteers.**



*Merit badge counselors who are not also registered in a unit position are **not** allowed to attend overnight Scouting activities/events.*

Effective April 1, 2024, National membership fees will be changed as follows:

Key changes

- Youth membership fees will increase \$5 to \$87 per year. **The \$25 one-time new member joining fee has been eliminated.**
- Adult membership fees will increase \$5 to \$67 per year
- All other fees will have no increase
- *includes \$2 Council insurance fee

Important rechartering note:

This change applies to all units currently rechartering not posted by March 31, 2024. (NOTE: it can take up to one week for a charter to be processed). This includes units who have not turned in their charter AND units that are unable to be posted due to one or more errors. All charters not posted are now past due. Please work with District Executive, Michaela Freiburger, to turn in your charter and resolve any errors so it can be posted in a timely manner and not subject to these additional fees.

\$100/YR

For all new and existing units.

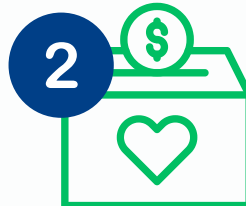

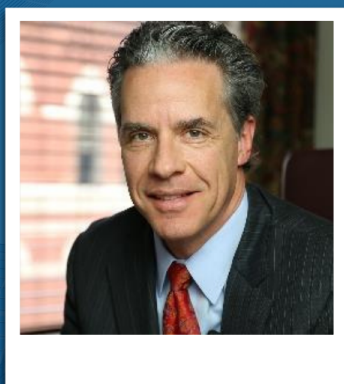
