INVITE NEW FAMILIES TO JOIN SCOUTING!

The beginning of the school year is filled with busy schedules and sometimes nervous kids as families navigate the first few weeks of their new schedule. Before those schedules have filled up, it's time to invite new families to join Cub Scouts and Scouts BSA!

Did you know that the **#1 reason** someone joined Scouting is because someone asked them? A flier, billboard, or social media post only reinforces that personal ask.

It's simple! Share what activities they get to do and what you and your child are getting out of the program. In person works best, but social media or text work too. Then invite the family to visit an informational night or other unit activity. Some people can be hesitant to commit before learning more, so make sure to let them know it is for information only and there is no pressure to join. Getting them there is the hard part; most families get excited about Scouting and join the same night. **IMPORTANT:** Don't say "no" for them. i.e. "They didn't join last year," or "They're probably too busy." The worst they can say is no but give them that chance!

Remember to encourage them to sign up for a **FREE** Adventure Kit at www.scoutsiowa.org/grit. They get a taste of Scouting without signing up yet, and the unit has contact information to follow up with them.

Bonus: They get a series of e-mails that shows them the awesome adventure of Scouting!

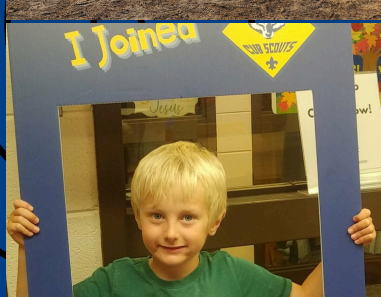

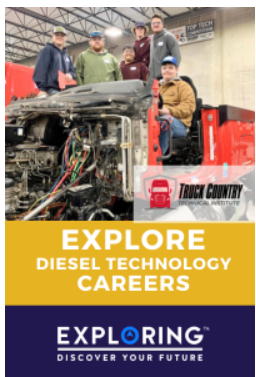
