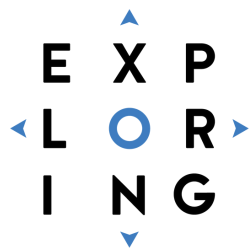
SCOUTS BSA: All youth ages 11–17
