

Specialty Awards

Venturers can earn awards like the Ranger Award for outdoor skills, the Quest Award for sports, the TRUST Award for religious and community life, and the Nova Awards for STEM achievements



Tiers of Adventure

Venturing offers three levels of adventure: Tier I (basic, short-term activities), Tier II (moderate, multi-day activities), and Tier III (extensive, high-challenge activities). These adventures help Venturers build skills and leadership through progressively challenging experiences



Youth Leadership
